ORDINANCE NO. 2013-3099

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS AFFECTING THE RMF-2 ZONE (Block 163, Lot 10)

WHEREAS, Four Ponds Center Associates ("Four Ponds") sought site plan approval for a total of 342 units on property known as Block 1063, Lot 10 as shown on the tax map of the Township of Middletown; and

WHEREAS, for various reasons, the Planning Board denied the application by a resolution dated August 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Four Ponds filed a Complaint in Lieu of Prerogative Writs with the Superior Court of New Jersey challenging that denial; and

WHEREAS, an Order was entered by the Honorable Paul A. Kapalko, J.S.C. on September 10, 2013 remanding the matter to the Planning Board for further proceedings consistent with the Order and the Court's Opinion of August 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding, the Planning Board and Four Ponds have discussed a possible settlement of this matter to avoid future litigation and to protect the best interests of the residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board and Four Ponds have reached a proposed settlement to stay the litigation contingent upon the rezoning of the subject property by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown to permit a maximum of 228 units; and

WHEREAS, the proposed settlement does not grant any approvals from the Planning Board to Four Ponds, and requires further public hearings on an application for up to 228 units, after the contemplated rezoning by the governing body as a condition precedent to the settlement of the matter; and

WHEREAS, the RMF-2 zone standards in this Ordinance are intended to apply to residential townhouse developments, and except as applied to residential townhouse developments as contemplated herein, pre-existing, Office-Research (OR-1) Zoning Standards shall apply.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that section 16-954 of the Code of the Township of Middletown be and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

A. Minimum Regulations.

1. Gross Lot Area at time of initial application 65 acres

2. Tract Frontage Minimum 100 feet

3. Minimum Building Setbacks

B. Maximum Regulations.

- C. *Design Standards*. In addition to any applicable architectural and building design standards set forth in Section 16-604, the following design standards shall apply:
- 1. Exterior building facades shall incorporate design features such as offsets, balconies, projections, window reveals, or similar elements to preclude large expanses of uninterrupted building surfaces. Along the vertical face of a building, such features shall occur at a minimum of every thirty-two (32') feet, and, to the greatest degree practicable, contain a minimum of one (1) of the following features:
- a. Recesses (e.g., deck, patio, courtyard, entrance, window reveals) that have a minimum depth of three (3') feet;
- b. Extensions (e.g., floor area, deck, patio, window bay, fireplace chase, entrance) that have a minimum depth of one (1') foot and minimum length of four (4') feet; and/or
 - c. Offsets or breaks in roof elevation of one (1') foot or greater in height.

- 2. Adequate, accessible and secure storage space shall be provided for each dwelling unit. A minimum of one hundred twelve (112) cubic feet of enclosed storage shall be required separate from each living unit. This is an area 4' x 4' x 7'. Garages and storage units adjoining a dwelling (e.g., attached to decks and patios) shall qualify as storage space.
- 3. Trash receptacles shall not be located in any front yard setback, or within seventy-five (75') feet of an adjacent property line.
 - 4. Dwelling Units shall have a two (2) car garage.

PASSED ON FIRST READING: December 2, 2013

D. Other Regulations.

- 1. Temporary construction trailers shall be permitted where active construction work is proposed. Such trailers shall not be placed on site until the start of land development activities, but in no case more than seven (7) days prior to the commencement of work. Trailers shall not remain on site more than seven (7) days after the completion of all work. Temporary construction trailers shall not be placed within the right-of-way of any improved public road.
- 2. No affordable housing set aside and no affordable housing fee shall be applicable to any development constructed pursuant to this Ordinance.
- 3. Definitions applicable to this Ordinance shall be those definitions found in Township Code Section 16-203, except that building height shall be calculated by measurement from the average grade at the front of the building when a building is constructed on a slope in a walk-out condition; and building setback calculations shall not apply to decks and patios, but decks and patios may be no closer than 60 feet from an existing residence or residential zone.
- 4. The driveway/roadway setback from tract boundary or other right-of-way shall not be applicable to existing, secondary access roadways; any existing, secondary access roadways may be modified to satisfy Residential Site Improvement Standards.

2014 SALARY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, substantial savings have been achieved through many recent years of salary freezes, the elimination of numerous positions through layoffs and attrition, and the entry of numerous shared agreements for the provision of shared services, therefore, requiring many management and unclassified employees to assume significant additional responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2011-3027, the Township Committee reasserted control over the setting of salaries by ordinance rather than the setting of ranges by ordinance with the subsequent passage of resolutions ratifying the Township Administrator's actions in setting specific salaries; and

WHEREAS, the setting of specific salaries by ordinance provides greater public awareness and an opportunity to participate in and understand how and why salaries of public employees are annually set.

The same health benefits shall also be provided subject to the contribution requirements established pursuant to P.L. 2011, c.78, as required by law when no contract is in place. This Section shall supersede Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2006-2856 and shall be retroactive to the expiration of the same but for the applicability of P.L. 2011, c.78 until its effective date.

SECTION 6.Repealer.

All ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict of inconsistency.

SECTION 7.Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication in accordance with law with a retroactive effect to January 1, 2014 if necessary.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SPECIAL FINDINGS IN SUPPORT OF THE ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2013-3099

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2013, the Township Committee introduced Ordinance No. 2013-3099, an ordinance Amending the Standards and Regulations Affecting the RMF-2 Zone; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26, Ordinance No. 2013-3099 was referred to the Planning Board for review as to its consistency with the Land Use and Housing Elements of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board reviewed Ordinance No. 2013-3099 at its regular meeting of December 4, 2013, and subsequently provided a report to the Township Committee dated December 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board's report outlines certain areas of consistency and inconsistency between the introduced ordinance and the current Land Use and Housing Plan Elements of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant N.J.S.A.40:55D-62a, the governing body is empowered to enact zoning ordinances or amendments that in whole or part may be inconsistent with the Land Use or Housing Element of the Master Plan so long as a resolution is adopted setting forth its reasons for such deviations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-62a, it hereby finds as follows:

• The Township's Master Plan, Land Use Element and Housing Plan require a comprehensive review and update, particularly as a result of the current instability and lack of direction from either the State of New Jersey or the Courts with regard to implementation of the Fair Housing Act, the current status of the New Jersey Council on Affordable Housing ("COAH"), and the current status of Middletown's Substantively Certified Housing Plan last adopted in 2009 premised upon the second version of the Third Round rules adopted by COAH that have, once again, been disposed of by the courts.

- It would be costly and inefficient for the Township to make major changes to its Land Use and Housing policies in a vacuum, lacking any guidance or direction as to how the State intends to implement the mandate of the New Jersey Supreme Court in its September 26, 2013 decision to develop new regulations within five months for which no progress or updates have been made readily apparent.
- The proposed ordinance before the Township Committee cannot wait for clarity or
 direction on these complex issues as the matter is presently before the Planning Board
 and pending as a condition of settlement in the long pending matter of <u>Four Ponds Center</u>
 <u>Associates v. Township of Middletown Planning Board</u>, currently on remand from the
 Superior Court.
- The Township Committee concurs with the Planning Board's finding, per its report dated December 9, 2013, that Ordinance 2013-3099 is, in part, inconsistent with the Land Use and Housing Elements of the Master Plan.
- The Township hereby finds that the proposed ordinance is drawn with reasonable consideration to the character of the district in which the land is located and is, in fact, more consistent with the developed character of the area than the current zoning is.
- With regard to overall intensity and density of development, the proposed ordinance will result in a reduced intensity of development not a greater one, nor will the overall use or boundaries of the zone change.
- The Township Committee hereby finds that there will be no detriment to the public good or the public health safety and welfare by the adoption of Ordinance No. 2013-3099 and that detriments associated with adoption, despite certain inconsistencies with the Land Use and Housing Elements of the Master Plan, are outweighed by the detriments of not doing so, in particular, the escalating costs associated with protracted litigation.

BE IT FURHTER RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-16, the Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution along with Ordinance No. 2013-3099 to the County Planning Board.

The Grantor does hereby convey to the Grantee for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and other good and valuable consideration paid by the Grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, an Easement for conservation purposes on property lying and being situated in the Township of Middletown, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, which property is further known and designated as a portion of Block 605, Lot 59 on the Tax Map of the Township of Middletown. Said property is more particularly described on Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This Deed is intended to create a Conservation Easement over a portion of property known and designated as Block 605, Lot 59 as a condition of Major Site Plan and Use Variance Approval by Resolution of the Zoning Board of Adjustment of the Township of Middletown, dated October 25, 2010, approving the Preliminary/Final Plat Major Site Plan for 180 Turning Lives Around, Inc., Lot 59, Block 605, Tax

Map Sheet 100, dated April, 1988, Township of Middletown, Monmouth County, New Jersey, prepared by Kennedy Consulting Engineers, LLC, dated January 29, 2008 approving the site plan prepared by Kennedy Consulting Engineers, LLC, dated January 29, 2008 and revised through September 10, 2013; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of said Resolution, the Grantor has agreed to provide a Conservation Easement in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Zoning and Land Use Regulations Ordinance, for the purpose of protecting, preserving and, where necessary, restoring environmentally sensitive lands and natural features from destructive uses, and to establish parameters and guidelines specifying permitted and prohibited activities within the Conservation Easement area so as to prevent substantial disturbance within the Conservation Easement; and

WHEREAS, this Conservation Easement is further intended to protect environmental conditions including stormwater drainage right-of-ways, buffers or transition areas along ponds, rivers, marshes, swamps, streams, brooks and creeks, slope areas in excess of fifteen percent (15%), habitat for fish and wildlife, and the prevention of siltation and pollution of streams, similar water courses and their adjacent land; and

WHEREAS, the Grantor desires to grant to Grantee a Conservation Easement as hereinafter described.

- NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the facts recited above, and the benefits of the mutual covenants, terms, conditions and restrictions contained herein, the Grantor does hereby grant a Conservation Easement to the Grantee, subject to the following terms and conditions:
- 1. The following activities shall be prohibited within the Conservation Easement except as may be otherwise expressly provided herein:
- (a) Construction of or placing of buildings, roads, signs, billboards or other structures on or above the ground.
- (b) Dumping or placing of soil or other substances or materials as land fill or dumping or placing of trash, waste or unsightly or offensive materials.

- (c) Removal or destruction of trees, shrubs or other vegetation except as may be permitted pursuant to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Regulations governing fresh water wetlands.
- (d) Excavating, dredging or removal of loam, peat, gravel, soil, rock or other mineral substance.
- (e) Surface use except for purposes permitting the land or water area to remain predominantly in its natural condition.
- (f) Activities detrimental to drainage, flood control, water conservation, erosion control or soil conservation, or fish and wildlife habitat preservation.
- (g) Installation of fences shall be prohibited within the Conservation Easement. This requirement may be waived by the appropriate approving authority when determined to be necessary in the interest of safety. Such fences shall be as permitted by the approving authority. The approving authority shall seek comments from the Environmental Commission prior to taking action on any request to place a fence within the Conservation Easement. The Zoning Board of Adjustment of the Township of Middletown shall be the appropriate approving authority.
- 2. The following activities shall be permitted within the Conservation Easement:
- (a) Periodic selective thinning of dead or diseased small trees, shrub growth and brush in order to maintain pedestrian access and/or overall vegetative health in and throughout the Conservation Easement area.
- (b) Establishment of a pond, subject to the approval of the construction official. In granting approval for a pond, the construction official shall secure the advice of the Township Engineer and Environmental Commission in order to determine that such activity will be environmentally sound and that drainage conditions on adjacent land will not be negatively impacted.
- (c) Other activities permitted by a validated NJDEP individual freshwater wetlands, statewide general freshwater wetlands, stream encroachment, flood hazard area or such other applicable permit issued by NJDEP.

(d) Such other activities as may be specified and permitted by the Ordinances of the Township of Middletown within Conservation Easements.

The Grantor, its successors and assigns, agree that it will advise any prospective purchaser of the location and significance of this Conservation Easement.

The maintenance of this Conservation Easement shall be the obligation of the owner of the property.

Grantor reserves to itself and its personal representatives, heirs, successors and assigns all rights accruing from their ownership of the property, including the right to engage in, or permit, or invite others to engage in, all uses of the property that are not expressly prohibited herein, and are not inconsistent with the purposes of this Easement.

No right of access by the general public to any portion of the property is conveyed by this Easement.

Grantee shall not be responsible for any real property taxes and assessments levied by competent authority on the property.

Grantor intends that the enforcement of the terms and provisions of this Easement shall be at the discretion of the Grantee and that any forbearance on behalf of the Grantee to exercise its rights hereunder in the event of any breach hereof by Grantor, its heirs, successors, personal representatives or assigns, shall not be deemed or construed to be a waiver of Grantee's rights hereunder in the event of any subsequent breach.

In order to enforce this Easement, the following rights are conveyed to the Grantee:

- (a) To enter upon the property at reasonable times to enforce the rights herein granted in a manner that will not unreasonably interfere with the use and quiet enjoyment of the property by the Grantor, its heirs, successors, or assigns at the time of such entry.
- (b) To enjoin any prohibited activity on or uses of the restricted area as described above and to enforce the restoration of such areas or features of restricted area that may be damaged by such prohibited activity or use.

Nothing contained in this easement shall be construed to entitle Grantee to bring any action against Grantor for any injury to or change in the property resulting from causes beyond Grantor's control, including, without limitation, fire, storm, earth movement, or from any prudent action taken by Grantor under emergency conditions to prevent, abate or mitigate significant injury to the property resulting from such causes.

If any provision of this Easement or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is found to be invalid, the remainder of the provisions of this Easement and the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is found to be invalid shall not be affected thereby.

ARTICLE I NAME AND LOCATION OF CORPORATION

SECTION 1. The name of the Corporation is MIDDLETOWN SENIOR CITIZENS HOUSING CORPORATION. The principal office is located at Bayshore Village, 100 Shoal Harbor Court, Port Monmouth, Monmouth County, New Jersey.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Corporation is to provide for the elderly (at least one person in a household being 62 years old or older) and handicapped families and persons on a nonprofit basis, rental housing and related facilities and services especially designed to meet the physical, social and psychological needs of the aged or handicapped and contribute to their health, security, happiness and usefulness in longer living.

ARTICLE III BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SECTION I. Number and Qualifications.

The affairs of the Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors composed of five (5) persons, except as otherwise required by law. There shall also be two (2) residents of Bayshore Village who will act as liaisons to the Board of Directors, who will be broadly representative of the residential community and who shall provide the Board with relevant information as it relates to the resident's concerns and social activities. However, said representatives shall have no voting rights as it relates to any business that comes before the Board, nor shall their presence be considered as to constituting a quorum for purposes of holding a meeting or voting upon any action that may come before the Board. The Directors and Liaisons shall be selected as follows:

SECTION II. Selection.

- (A) The Township Committee of the Township of Middletown shall appoint the five (5) Members of the Board of Directors who shall serve for the period as hereinafter set forth.
- (B) The two (2) Resident Liaisons shall be selected from among the residents of the Housing Project (Bayshore Village).

SECTION III. Term of Office.

(A) The term of the Directors which are appointed by the Township Committee shall be for a period of five (5) years. The term of each Director so appointed shall expire on the 31st day of December of their fifth year, or until such time that their successor has been appointed and qualified.

- (B) The President or Secretary of the Board of Directors shall be responsible for notifying the Township Committee of the names of those Directors whose terms are about to expire. Said notice shall be provided to the Township Committee at least 90 days prior to the expiration of said Director's term.
- (C) The term of the Resident Liaisons selected by the residents of the Housing Project (Bayshore Village) will be by annual election which will be held on the 1st Tuesday of December in the Bayshore Village Community Room. Any one (1) current Director or appointee of any Director shall witness the election of the Resident Liaisons.
- (D) All Directors shall hold office until their successors have been appointed and qualified.

SECTION IV. Vacancies.

- (A) Vacancies on the Board of Directors caused by any reason or at the request of the State Agency shall be filled in the same manner as the vacating Director was selected in ARTICLE III, Section II above.
- (B) Township Committee shall be advised of the vacancy requesting that the appointment of a new Director take place within thirty (30) days of when they are so notified. Once appointed and qualified, said Director will serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of the vacating Director.
- (C) Vacancies with respect to the Resident Liaisons shall be filled by a special election of the residents of Bayshore Village, to be held on the 1st Tuesday of the month following which the current resident liaison advises that they are unable, for any reason, to continue to serve. Once selected and qualified, said resident liaison shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- (D) In the event that the Township of Middletown governing body fails to appoint by the next Board Meeting, the President of the Board may request in writing that the Township Committee and/or Mayor fill the vacancy. If no appointment is made, the Board of Directors shall advise the Township Committee that in order to conduct the business and affairs of the Corporation, the Board will submit the name(s) of candidates to the Township Committee requesting that the Township of Middletown governing body appoint said candidate(s) to fill the vacancy. Said Director so appointed shall serve the unexpired term of the vacating Director.

SECTION V. Removal of Directors.

At any annual or special meeting duly called, any one or more of the members of the Board of Directors may be removed with cause upon an affirmative vote of a majority of the entire members of the Board of Directors. Said Director(s) shall also be removed at the request of the

New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, which again will require an affirmative vote of a majority of the entire Board of Directors. A successor Director may then be appointed in the same manner as set forth in Article III, Section II above to fill the vacancy thus created. Any Director whose removal has been requested shall be entitled to notice, personally or by certified mail at least seven (7) days prior to said meeting, setting forth the date, time and place of the regular or special meeting, the action to be taken and further provided with an opportunity to be heard at said meeting.

SECTION VI. Compensation.

Directors shall not be entitled to receive any compensation for their services as Directors of the Corporation.

SECTION VII. Annual Meeting.

Except as otherwise provided by law, the annual meeting of the Board of Directors for the purposes of election of officers and the consideration of any other business that may be properly brought before it shall be held on the 3rd Tuesday of January of each year, except that in the event that said day is a legal holiday, or quorum is lacking, the annual meeting shall be held on the following Tuesday, at such place as the Board may, from time to time, determine. If the election of Officers shall not be held on the date designated for the annual meeting, or at any adjournment thereof, the Board of Directors shall cause the election to be held at a special meeting of the Board called as soon thereafter as conveniently may be held.

SECTION VIII. Regular Meetings.

Regular Meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at such time and place as shall be determined, from time to time, by a majority of the five Directors, but at least eight such meetings shall be held during the fiscal year. Notice of regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be given to each Director, personally, or by mail, telephone, fax, electronic mail or instant messaging at least three (3) days prior to the day named for the meeting.

SECTION IX. Special Meetings.

Special meeting of the Board of Directors may be called by the President on three (3) days notice to each Director, given personally, or by mail, telephone, fax, electronic mail or instant messaging, which notice shall state the time, place and purpose of the meetings. Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called by the President or Secretary in like manner and on like notice on the written request of at least (3) three Directors.

SECTION X. Notice.

Written or printed notice stating the place, day, and hour of any meeting of the Board of Directors shall be delivered, personally, by mail, e-mail, telecopy, or fax to each Director entitled to vote at such meeting. When required by statute or by these By-Laws, the purpose for which the meeting is called shall be stated in the notice. If mailed, the notice of a meeting shall be

delivered when deposited in the United States mail, addressed to the Director at his or her address as it appears in the records of the Corporation. If notice is given by e-mail, it shall be deemed to be delivered upon sender's receipt confirming same. If notice is given by fax, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when the notice is faxed to the intended recipient's facsimile number.

Notice of any special meeting of the Board of Directors shall be given at least three days prior thereto by written notice, delivered personally or sent by mail, e-mail or fax to each Director at his address as shown by the records of the Corporation. Said notice shall be deemed to have been delivered in the same manner as set forth above related to any annual or general meeting.

SECTION XI. Waiver of Notice.

Before or at any meeting of the Board of Directors, any Director may, in writing, waive notice of such meeting and such waiver shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice. Attendance by a director at any meeting of the Board shall be waiver of notice by him at the time and place thereof. If all the Directors are present at any meeting of the Board, no notice shall be required and any business may be transacted at such meeting. To the extent permitted by law, any lawful action by the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting if written consent to such action is signed by all the Directors and filed with the minutes of the Board.

SECTION XII. Quorum.

At all meetings of the Board of Directors, a majority of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the acts of the majority of the Board present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the acts of the Board of Directors, except where a large number is required by law, Articles of Incorporation, or these By-Laws. If, at any meeting of the Board of Directors there is less than a quorum present, the majority of those present may adjourn the meeting and no business will be conducted.

ARTICLE IV EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

SECTION I. Designation.

The Board of Directors, by resolution adopted by a majority of the entire Board of Directors, may designate three (3) Board of Directors to constitute an Executive Committee. The designation of such Executive Committee, and the delegation of authority herein granted shall not operate to relieve the Board of Directors or any member thereof of any responsibility imposed on them by law. No member of the Executive Committee shall continue to be a member thereof after he ceases to be a Director of the Corporation. The Board of Directors shall have the power at any time to change the number of members of the Executive Committee, to fill the vacancies therein, to replace any member thereof, to change the functions, or terminate the existing thereof.

SECTION II. Powers.

During the intervals between meetings of the Board of Directors, and subject to such limitations as may be provided by law, these By-Laws, or by resolution of the Board of Directors, the Executive Committee shall have and may exercise all the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the Corporation. The Executive Committee shall make a full report of all actions at the next meeting of the Board of Directors, and to the extent necessary, a formal vote of the entire Board shall take place to ratify the actions of the Executive Committee.

SECTION III. Meetings.

Meetings of the Executive Committee may be held at such time and place as may be from time to time determined by the Executive Committee upon the giving of notice personally, or by mail, telephone, fax, electronic mail or instant messaging at least two (2) days prior to the day named for the meeting.

ARTICLE V OFFICERS

SECTION I. Designation.

The principle officers of the corporation shall be a President, one Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, all of whom shall be elected by the Board of Directors, from among its members. No two officers, except those of Secretary and Treasurer, may be held by the same person.

SECTION II. Election of Officers.

The officers of the Corporation shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors at its annual meeting, and, unless sooner removed by the Board, the officers shall serve for a term of one year and until their successors are elected and shall qualify. Any vacancies occurring in the offices shall be filled by the Board of Directors, from time to time. The Board of Directors shall appoint such temporary or acting officers as may be necessary during the temporary absence or disability of the regular officer.

SECTION III. Removal of Officers.

Upon an affirmative vote of a majority of the entire members of the Board of Directors, any officer may be removed, for good cause, at any regular or special meeting, and his successor elected at any regular meeting of the Board of Directors or at any special meeting called for such purpose.

SECTION IV. President.

The President shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation. He/she shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors. He or she shall have all the general power and duties which

are usually vested in the office of the President of a Corporation, including the power to appoint committees from time to time as in his or her discretion he or she may deem appropriate to assist in the conduct of the affairs of the Corporation. He or she shall have the power to execute, on behalf of the Corporation, and with their approval, all other contracts as well as any documents that may be required in order to conduct the business of the Corporation.

SECTION V. Vice President.

There shall be one Vice President, as the Board of Directors shall from time to time determine. In absence or of disability of the President, the Vice President shall perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President. The Vice President shall also perform such other duties as shall be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

SECTION VI. Secretary.

The Secretary, or his or her designee, shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors, of the membership and of the Executive Committee. He or she shall have custody of the seal of the Corporation, and of such other books and records of the Corporation as the Board of Directors may provide or the Secretary may appoint someone to fulfill such obligations on his or her behalf. He or she shall perform the duties and functions customarily performed by the Secretary of a Corporation together with other duties as the Board of Directors may prescribe. All records will be maintained in the office of the Corporation.

SECTION VII. Treasurer.

The Treasurer, or his or her designee, shall have custody of the Corporate funds and securities, and shall keep full and accurate account of all receipts and disbursements in books belonging to the Corporation and shall deposit all monies and other valuable effects in the name of and to the credit of the Corporation in such depositories as may be designated by the Board of Directors. He or she shall disburse the funds of the Corporation as may be ordered by the Board of Directors, taking proper vouchers for such disbursements, and shall render an account of all his transactions as Treasurer and of the financial condition of the Corporation whenever called upon to do so or the Treasurer may appoint someone to fulfill such obligations on his or her behalf.

ARTICLE VI AMENDMENTS

SECTION I.

Except as otherwise required by law, these By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting of the Board of Directors, or at any special meeting called for that purpose, provided that written notice of the proposed amendment shall have been given at least ten (10) days prior to such meeting. Such amendment shall be required to have an affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the Board of Directors present at a duly constituted meeting and shall further require the written approval of the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown, and the New

Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, where has here and throughout these By-Laws been referred to "Agency".

ARTICLE VII CORPORATE SEAL

SECTION I.

The Board of Directors shall maintain a Corporate Seal for the Corporation, which shall be affixed to all documents, the execution of which will be on behalf of the Corporation under its seal, duly authorized and in accordance with the provision of these By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII FISCAL MANAGEMENT

SECTION I. Fiscal Year.

The fiscal year of the Corporation shall begin on the 1st day of April of every year. The commencement date of the fiscal year herein established shall be subject to the change of the Board of Directors, with the prior written approval of the Agency.

SECTION II. Books and Accounts.

All books of account and other records of the Corporation, as well as the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors, shall be kept at the registered principal of office of said Corporation. Said books and accounts to be maintained in accordance with the requirements of the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, as well as the New Jersey Public Housing and Development Authority.

SECTION III. Auditing and Reports.

At the close of each fiscal year, the books and records of the Corporation shall be audited in accordance with the requirements of the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall cause to be prepared annually a full and correct statement and financial statement of operations for the preceding year (fiscal) which shall be submitted to the Board at their next regular meeting after said statements are completed and submitted for approval and filing with both the Secretary of the Corporation as well as submission to the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency.

SECTION IV. Execution of Corporate Documents.

With the prior authorization of the Board of Directors, all notes and contracts shall be executed on behalf of the Corporation by either the President or a Vice President, and attested by the Secretary or Treasurer, and all checks executed on behalf of the Corporation by the President or

Vice President, or the Managing Agent or his or her designee and countersigned by any appointed Board Member or their designees.

SECTION V. Fidelity Bonds.

The Board of Directors shall require that all officers and employers of the Corporation having custody or control of Corporate funds furnish adequate fidelity bonds. The Premiums on such bonds shall be paid by the Corporation.

SECTION VI. Indemnity.

Each officer, director or employee of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against expenses reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with any action, suit or proceeding to which he or she may be made a party by reason of his or her being, or having been, an officer, Director or employee of the Corporation, except in relation to matters as to which he or she shall be finally adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding to have been derelict in the performance of his or her duty as officer, or Director, or employee.

ARTICLE IX COMMITTEES

SECTION I. Appointment of Committee Members and Term of Office.

The President shall appoint members to any Committee. Each Committee member shall hold office for the term for which the Committee member is elected and qualified and until his or her successor is elected and qualified, unless the Committee shall be terminated or said member shall cease to qualify as a member thereof.

SECTION II.

No Committee shall:

- (1) Make, alter or repeal any By-Law of the Corporation.
- (2) Elect or appoint any Director, or remove any Officer or Director.
- (3) Amend or repeal any resolution previously adopted by the Board.

SECTION III. Chair person.

One member of each Committee shall be appointed Chair person by the President. Said person shall hold office for the term for which the appointment is made and until his or hers successor is appointed, unless the Committee shall be terminated or said individual shall cease to qualify as a member thereof.

SECTION IV. Vacancies.

Vacancies in the membership of any Committee shall be filed by appointment made in the same manner as provided in the case of the original appointments.

SECTION V. Quorum.

Unless otherwise provided, the majority of the whole Committee shall constitute a quorum and the action of a majority of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Committee.

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING RENEWAL OF FEDERAL BROWNFIELD TAX INCENTIVE

WHEREAS, authorization of the Federal Brownfield Tax Incentive that had been part of the Internal Revenue Code lapsed in 2012; and

WHEREAS, this incentive allowed property owners who cleaned-up contaminated properties to deduct their remediation costs in the years in which such costs are incurred on their federal tax returns, therefore, accelerating the clean-up of the nation's contaminated sites; and

WHEREAS, this tax incentive was approved and reauthorized on a bipartisan basis from 1997 through 2011; and

WHEREAS, absent such incentives, the largest single cost of taking on the redevelopment of a brownfield, the remediation of it, will result in brownfields remaining contaminated, which can spread to adjoining properties while harming the public health, safety and welfare of residents; and

WHEREAS, the Brownfield Tax Incentive not only accelerated the remediation of contaminated sites, but generated positive economic activity in more desirable areas through the reuse of previously developed, idle or currently underutilized properties rather than environmentally sensitive open space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the Township Committee hereby supports and endorses the renewal of the Federal Brownfield Tax Incentive previously authorized under section 198 of the Internal Revenue Code to help incentivize the clean-up, redevelopment and reuse of idle or underutilized contaminated brownfields that continue to harm the environment and local tax base.
